A student may be offered a position as an instructional student assistant if they meet the following criteria:

Student has been admitted or is currently registered as a CSU student.
Student is being offered a part-time position (but may work full-time during academic breaks).
The majority of the work performed by the student will be tutoring, grading, and/or teaching.
Student may be required to complete specific coursework in order to teach, grade, or tutor a
course.
Assignments for the student will be made by an academic department or equivalent
administrative unit by a specific supervisor.
Work-Study Instructional Student Assistants must meet eligibility requirements of the Federal
Work-Study Program, as determined by the campus' Financial Aid office.
Federal Work-Study appointments must meet the provisions of the Federal Work-Study
Program and are not limited by a maximum number of hours.
