

Guide for Travelers in Case of Emergency

In the event of an emergency—whether medical, travel, personal, or security-related—it's crucial to know the steps to take for immediate assistance and support. This guide outlines the actions you should follow to ensure your safety and well-being while traveling.

Immediate Steps in Case of Emergency:

1. Contact AXA Assistance:

- o AXA Assistance partners with Chubb to provide global travel and medical support. They can help you access local care and assistance wherever you are.

2. Information to Provide:

- o Name of the caller or relationship to the covered person
- o Covered person's full name and date of birth.
- Covered person's policy number (can be found at the bottom of 2024-2025 CHUBB Travel Assist document)
- o Covered person's organization name (California State University Fullerton)
- o Reason for calling

3. Notify University Contact:

Services Available:

• Medical Assistance:

- o Medical provider referrals, monitoring, and treatment
- o Emergency medical evacuations and repatriation
- o Dispatch of physician or prescription medication

• Travel Assistance:

- o Emergency travel arrangements and general travel information
- o Lost/stolen personal item assistance
- o Translator or interpreter assistance

• Security Assistance:

- o 24/7 security advice and crisis response
- o Support for security, natural disaster, or political evacuation

Accessing Travel Assistance Portal:

- Visit <u>travelassistance.chubb.com</u> for real-time health, security, and travel resources.
- Register or log in to access tools and alerts.



• Download the mobile app for iOS or Android after registering via the desktop site.

Important Notes:

- Always carry your Travel Identification Card for quick access to services.
- Services may require payment if not covered by your policy. Ensure you understand the terms and conditions of your coverage.
